




Tables That Define Space

MATERIALITY

Wood, Concrete & Metal – A Dialogue Between Elements

Atelier Sept doesn't impose form; it listens. Materials speak — in grain, in weight, in silence. The studio responds, shaping what already wants to become.

Oak, elm, and pine bring structure and stillness — woods with memory. Salvaged timber carries the past in its texture. Concrete holds space: raw, heavy, quiet. Steel and brass arrive like punctuation — minimal, deliberate.

Nothing is frozen. Every material is left to age, deepen, shift. Good design does not resist time — it absorbs it.

6 FINISHES

To complement the models in this catalogue, Atelier Sept introduces six curated finishes. These tones are not fixed choices, but thoughtful suggestions — each one adding nuance, contrast, or quiet richness to the form.

The finishes offer material depth and variation across models, allowing a sense of continuity or distinction depending on the piece.

Alba \cdot Maro \cdot Calx \cdot Sombre* \cdot Umber \cdot Nero

Sombre is subject to specific application restrictions due to its treatment and tone.

2/ Maro – Soft blonde-beige, classic and muted. 3/ Calx - Chalky midtone with a raw, mineral edge

4/ Sombre - Raw and characterful

5/ Umber - Deep earth tone, rich and historic.
